


# **ABOUT** AL-AYN

# HOW CHILD SPONSORSHIP WORKS WITH AL-AYN



## IDENTIFYING CHILDREN IN NEED OF SPONSORSHIP SUPPORT

Our selection process is thorough and starts with closely monitoring and documenting cases requiring assistance. Our dedicated social workers conduct on-site visits to orphaned families, recording essential information about each family member and their living conditions.



## VERIFICATION

We cross-check the data for eligible orphaned children with relevant agencies. This involves assessing the financial resources of the orphaned child's family, housing conditions, furniture, and the physical and psychological well-being and educational level of family members.



## **EVALUATING NEEDS**

We conduct a comprehensive assessment to determine the family's eligibility for aid. This includes evaluating their overall financial situation, living conditions, and specific needs. By thoroughly understanding their circumstances, we can accurately calculate their required support.



### **SPONSORSHIP**

Families included in Al-Ayn's sponsorship programme start receiving financial benefits on fixed monthly dates.



### REASSESSMENT

We conduct a reassessment of those under our care every six months to confirm their eligibility for the provided aid. If these individuals have acquired adequate resources that alleviate their need for assistance, support is discontinued based on a fair and precise evaluation system.

Our financial aid initiative helps alleviate economic hardships, providing essential resources to meet basic needs and support the children's education and overall welfare. Through these efforts, we strive to create a nurturing environment where orphaned children can thrive.



Our health clinics in Iraq contain the latest equipment and devices and are staffed by expert medical practitioners. They offer free, long-term healthcare to children, including regular checkups and ongoing care for chronic conditions. Dedicated medical professionals collaborate with hospitals and physicians both within and outside the country to ensure that orphaned children with more complex needs receive the necessary support.

In Afghanistan and Ghana, we extend our commitment to quality healthcare. We ensure that orphaned children and families registered with Al-Ayn receive medical attention as needed. We offer assistance as required to ensure prompt access to essential treatment, including surgical procedures and necessary medications.





To date over 120,000 orphaned children have been treated with the support of health services provided by Al-Ayn.



## PSYCHOLOGICAL REHABILITATION IN IRAQ

Al-Ayn's Psychological Rehabilitation programme, accessible to sponsored children in Iraq, monitors the psychological well-being of the orphaned children under our care. It addresses cases requiring specialised interventions, ensuring comprehensive support for their mental health needs.

We use evidence-based mental health interventions, such as cognitive-behavioural therapy, group counselling, and other medical therapies, to cater to the unique needs of each child.

With over 3,600 registered cases in Iraq, our commitment ensures that orphaned children receive tailored support, addressing their specific needs and contributing to their overall well-being and development.



Al-Ayn has 8 Luminous Stars centres across Iraq, with 9 additional buildings under construction. They serve as safe havens for over 100,000 orphaned children and their families, offering sponsored children access to high quality healthcare, psychological rehabilitation, vocational training, and educational programmes. The staff at our Luminous Stars centres are trained professionals who prioritise the well-being and holistic development of vulnerable children and families.

# YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

#### WHAT DOES MY SPONSORSHIP COVER?

The guardian uses the monthly sponsorship payment to pay for the child's food, clothing, medication, school fees, and any other needs the child may have. The money is spent on the orphaned child, and this is regularly monitored by our devoted follow-up staff.

# CAN I CHOOSE THE CHILD I SPONSOR?

Al-Ayn's sponsorship process does not allow for choosing a specific child due to the nature of the needs and fairness in allocation. However, the foundation ensures that your sponsorship directly supports a child in need, providing them with essential services and support.

#### WILL I RECEIVE DETAILED INFORMATION ABOUT THE ORPHANED CHILD I SPONSOR?

Sponsors will recieve basic information which includes the name and date of birth of the orphaned child in Iraq, Afghanistan or Ghana.

#### CAN I CONTACT THE CHILD OR DIRECTLY MEET THEM?

Direct contact is not permitted. However, in Iraq, Al-Ayn can facilitate a visit between the sponsor and the child at the child's local Al-Ayn office, subject to the approval of the orphaned child and their guardian.

#### HOW IS SPONSORSHIP AID DISTRIBUTED?

Mothers (or guardians) of orphaned children receive their monthly stipends by visiting the Al-Ayn office on designated dates each month. Additionally, seasonal aid is available as needed during these collection periods.

#### ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS INVOLVED IN SPONSORING A CHILD?

No hidden or additional costs are involved in sponsoring a child with Al-Ayn. The monthly sponsorship fee covers all the support services provided to the child.

#### CAN I PAY FOR MY SPONSORSHIP IN ADVANCE?

Yes, you can pay a year's worth of sponsorship in advance. This would be £720 for a child in Iraq and £660 for a child in Ghana or £720 for a child in Afghanistan.

#### WHAT IS THE MINIMUM NOTICE PERIOD REQUIRED FOR CANCELLING A SPONSORSHIP?

We kindly request a minimum of four months' notice for cancelling a sponsorship. This allows us sufficient time to make necessary adjustments, and to allow enough time to find an alternative sponsor.

#### HOW CAN I START SPONSORING A CHILD?

#### WHAT IS THE MINIMUM PERIOD OF TIME I CAN SPONSOR AN ORPHANED CHILD?

For private sponsorship, we ask that you commit for at least a year in order to be matched with a particular orphaned child.

#### HOW DOES GROUP SPONSORSHIP WORK?

A collaborative effort to sponsor an orphaned child is possible. For instance, as a sports team, study group, student organisation, or simply as a group of friends. Please choose a representative from your group to correspond with us and complete the group sponsorship form.

The representative would be in charge of either gathering the required annual sponsorship sum and transferring it to us, or gathering the required monthly sum each month. Once the first payment is received, you will be given information on the sponsored child.
